02.09.25 Australia – Dubai

Depart Brisbane at 9.00pm on Emirates flight EK 435, arriving in Dubai at 5.10am the next morning.

Depart Sydney at 9.10pm on EK 413, arriving in Dubai at 5.40am the next morning.

Depart Melbourne at 9.15pm on EK 407, arriving in Dubai at 5.15am the next morning.

Depart Adelaide at 9.50pm on EK 441, arriving in Dubai at 5.30am the next morning.

03.09.25 Dubai – Nairobi, Kenya

All passengers depart Dubai at 10.15am on EK 719, arriving in Nairobi at 2.15pm.

Upon arrival at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport, we will be met and transferred to our hotel for an afternoon's relaxation and overnight stay.

04.09.25 Nairobi - Amboseli National Park

(B/L/D)

After a hearty breakfast we meet our guide and the rest of the group at reception for our pre-departure meeting at 8am. Kindly ensure you are packed and checked out prior to your pre-departure meeting as you will depart shortly after this.

The day starts with a morning game drive in Nairobi National Park. We then make our way to the Daphne Sheldrick Animal Orphanage for a visit. The institution is named after the wife of the late famous Naturalist, David William Sheldrick who was the founder warden of Tsavo East National Park in Kenya from its inception in 1948 to 1976. The baby animals are transported from the national park to the orphanage for a mud bath, and we'll have the opportunity to spend an hour with them. Lunch will follow before driving down to Amboseli National Park, arriving in the afternoon.

Accommodation: Kibo Safari Camp or similar

05.09.25 Amboseli National Park

(B/L/D)

Today we will head into the Amboseli National Park for a full day of game viewing in one of Kenya's most famous parks. Amboseli is known for its huge elephant bulls with their magnificent tusks, which make for the ultimate safari in Kenya. Picture magnificent wildlife with the snow-capped Mount Kilimanjaro in the background.

Accommodation: Kibo Safari Camp or similar

06.09.25 Amboseli - Arusha, Tanzania

(B/L/D)

This morning after a leisurely breakfast, we make our way to the Tanzania border and then onwards to Arusha. En route we stop and hike to the Marangu waterfalls. It is a moderately strenuous walk but well worth the effort at the foothills of Mount Kilimanjaro. We continue to Arusha via Moshi town, the gateway to the Kilimanjaro National Park. Please note that we will have a change of guide and vehicle at the border crossing into Tanzania.

Accommodation: The African Tulip or similar

07.09.25 Arusha - Tarangire National Park, Tanzania

(B/L/D)

After breakfast we will be collected from the hotel in Arusha and set off towards Tarangire National Park for a full day's game drive. The breath-taking views of the Masai Steppe, and the mountains to the south, make this safari to Tarangire a truly memorable experience. Tarangire is as well known for its huge elephant population as it is for the striking baobab trees. It forms the centre of an annual migratory cycle that includes up to 3,000 elephants, 25,000 wildebeest and 30,000 zebra that Tanzania is famous for.

Accommodation: Tarangire Simba Lodge or similar

08.09.25 Tarangire – Lake Manyara National Park, Tanzania

(B/L/D)

After breakfast we will be collected from the hotel and set off towards Lake Manyara National Park. The spectacular reserve is located at the north-western corner of Lake Manyara, a hallow soda lake, which lies at the foot of the Great Rift Valley's western escarpment. We enjoy a scenic drive in the park known not only for its large flocks of flamingos, but also for the elusive tree-climbing lions.

Accommodation: Karatu Simba Lodge or similar

09.09.25 Lake Manyara, Tanzania

(B/L/D)

After breakfast we set out to experience the cultural diversity of Mto-wa-Mbu, starting at the market and visiting a Chagga family producing banana beer and passing by many different farms. On the way our guide will introduce us to the various fruits and vegetables growing in the area and explain the irrigation system that sustains local crops. After having a delicious, home-cooked meal in a traditional homestead, we enjoy a visit to a Maasai Boma for the cultural encounter of a lifetime. The Maasai people are semi-nomadic herders, who choose to live a traditional lifestyle and are known for their distinctive traditional attire. In the late afternoon we embark on a walking tour to Lake Papyrus. Here we can view this magnificent lake filled with abundant birdlife and hippos. If time allows, we can do some light trekking up to the waterfall. From here, view the lake on top of the Rift valley wall, then onto the banana plantation and rice fields, ending off the tour with a local village visit. On completion of this culture filled day, we return to the lodge for dinner & overnight.

Accommodation: Karatu Simba Lodge or similar

10.09.25 Lake Manyara – Ngorongoro Crater, Tanzania – Serengeti National Park

(B/L/D)

This morning we have an early departure for a game drive in the world renowned Ngorongoro Crater. For many this wildlife spectacle is the pinnacle of their Africa safari experience. The Ngorongoro Crater boasts all of the 'Big 5', including a small population of endangered black rhino. After a picnic lunch, we head towards the Serengeti through the stunning Southern Plains. This is the area that the Serengeti is best known for – the endless, undulating grass savannah with rocky outcrops that serve as isolated wildlife refuges.

Accommodation: Kisura Serengeti Tented Camp or similar

11.09.25 Serengeti National Park, Tanzania

(B/L/D)

Today we spend a full day game driving around the Seronera area of the Serengeti. The Serengeti is divided into three main areas. Seronera is the most central and accessible region and this is where the Park's headquarters are based, as well as most of the larger lodges and communal campsites. This part of the Serengeti is characterised by open plains of grassland, packed with animals. The Seronera River is the lifeblood of the Serengeti and this area is renowned for great game viewing all

year round. It is also particularly good for lion and cheetah sightings, as well as the most elusive of all big cats, the leopard.

Accommodation: Kisura Serengeti Tented Camp or similar

12.09.25 Serengeti National Park, Tanzania

(B/L/D)

We have another exciting day of exploring the Serengeti National Park ahead of us. With lunch boxes provided we continue with game drives throughout the afternoon, scanning the endless plains, spotting many animals and truly realizing just why this national park is so famous. In the late afternoon we return to our accommodation.

Accommodation: Kisura Serengeti Tented Camp or similar

13.09.25 Serengeti – Lake Victoria, Tanzania

(B/L/D)

After breakfast we make our way to Lake Victoria. We pass through the villages of the Sukuma tribe, who grow ground nuts, sorghum and cassava as well as keeping livestock. Life carries on here simply as it has done for ages, but with a few poignant reminders of the 20th century. In the afternoon we have some time at leisure, or you may wish to take a bird-viewing walk along the lake shore.

Accommodation: Serenity on the Lake Resort or similar

14.09.25 Lake Victoria – Masai Mara National Reserve, Kenya

(B/L/D)

This morning we have the opportunity to take part in an included boat excursion to one of the local fishing villages, before we bid Lake Victoria farewell and continue our journey northwards across the border and back into Kenya. Here we head to the Masai Mara, the traditional land of the Maasai people, who are permitted to graze their cattle in this area. The Masai Mara covers an area that includes the riverine forests along the banks of the Mara and Talek rivers, acacia forests and the open plains of the Savannah. Please note that we will have a change of guide and vehicle at the border crossing back into Kenya.

Accommodation: Pride Inn Mara Camp or similar

15.09.25 Masai Mara National Reserve, Kenya

(B/L/D)

Today we spend the whole day game viewing in the world famous Masai Mara National Park. Here the various habitats are home to a great variety of game including lion, leopard, cheetah, zebra, wildebeest, giraffe, buffalo, jackal, topi, gazelle, impala and elephant. Hippopotamus and crocodile are also plentiful in the rivers, with an abundant bird life.

Accommodation: Pride Inn Mara Camp or similar

16.09.25 Masai Mara – Nairobi, Kenya

(B/L/D)

After breakfast we depart for Nairobi, the capital city of Kenya. We visit the Giraffe Centre and Karen Blixen Museum. The museum is the beautiful and historic farmhouse where Karen Blixen, author of “Out of Africa”, lived between 1917 and 1931 until she left Kenya after a series of personal tragedies.

In the late afternoon we arrive at our hotel. If time permits, we visit the Kazuri Beads Centre and workshop for those interested in shopping. Kazuri means “small and beautiful” in Swahili and it describes each striking ceramic bead which is shaped by hand by the women employed at the Kazuri workshop. Nairobi is a cosmopolitan, lively and interesting city. Its central business district is nicely compact and it is therefore a great place to tune into modern urban African life.

This evening we have an included dinner at the hotel and reminisce on our time in East Africa.

17.09.25 Nairobi - Dubai

(B) Today we are transferred to the airport for our flights home

Tarangire National Park is a gem on the northern safari circuit. Teeming with wildlife, especially in the dry season, this area is a safari-goers dream. Located near the new Sangaiwe Gate of Tarangire National Park. Tarangire Simba Lodge is situated in a wildlife-rich area with views to beautiful Lake Burunge, bordered by the park and a Wildlife Management Area. The setting is stunning, with a giant old Baobab tree anchoring one corner and a permeating feeling of real Africa.

Tarangire Simba Lodge consists of sixteen classic canvas safari tents situated permanently under thatch. The spacious tents are constructed on platforms complete with wooden floors, large en-suite dressing room, toilet and shower. Each room has a torch and umbrella for you to use during your stay with us and there is a power strip to charge your devices. There's a secure safe for your valuables. As the solar lighting may be dimmer than you're used to, we highly recommend you bring a headlamp or 'book light' for reading in bed at night.

Due to our solar electrical system it's not possible to use a hair dryer at Tarangire Simba. We kindly request that you don't attempt to plug in a hair dryer as in all likelihood it will blow the system resulting in loss of power to the entire lodge.

We can only accommodate CPAP (sleep apnea machines) if they run on battery power, as we don't have 24 hour electricity. You must be fully versed in how the machine works and able to assist the lodge staff in charging the battery. Please advise when booking if you use this device.



Karatu Simba Lodge

Experience the peace and quiet of the Tanzanian countryside. Karatu Simba Lodge has 23 tented camps and is located about a thirty-minute drive from the gate of Lake Manyara National Park, approximately four kilometres off the main road to the entry of the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. Situated deep in the farming area of the Karatu district and nestled right alongside the Ngorongoro Forest—home to elephant, buffalo, hyena, and other wildlife—Karatu Simba Lodge offers fine hospitality for safari travellers.

All rooms have a view to the forest, fields and far distant hills. Rooms at Karatu Simba are beautifully and simply decorated with local fabrics and hard wood furniture; the beds all have mosquito nets. Full amenities are provided and rooms are solar powered with solar heated water; there is a power strip for battery charging. Each room has a torch and umbrella for you to use during your stay with us. A whistle is also provided in case you need to alert the security guards.

As the solar lighting may be dimmer than you're used to, we highly recommend you bring a headlamp or 'book light' for reading in bed at night.

Due to our solar electrical system it's not possible to use a hair dryer at Karatu Simba. We kindly request that you don't attempt to plug in a hair dryer as in all likelihood it will blow the system resulting in loss of power to the entire lodge. We serve continental cuisine with an occasional sample of local dishes.

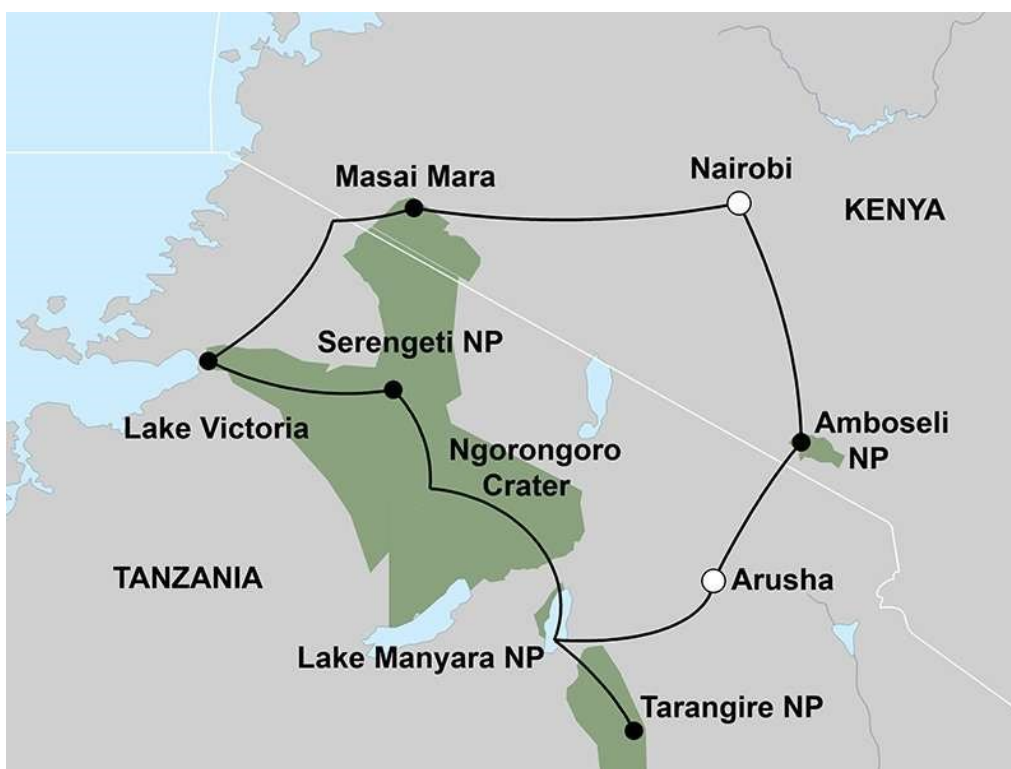
Tour Difficulty Ratings & Advice

Deposits and Payments - A non-refundable deposit of \$2,500 per person is payable within 7 days of booking. This deposit is not refundable or transferrable should you later cancel. The balance is payable in full 10 weeks prior to departure. Macleay Valley Travel has to adhere to strict payment deadlines and your booking on the tour may be cancelled if final payment is not received by the due date, with no refund.

Refunds and Cancellations - Cancellations after final payment will result in a refund limited to whatever we can recoup from the airline. Any refund for a cancelled booking will not be paid until the airline(s) have provided said refund.

Airline Tickets - Please note that any changes made to airline tickets once they have been issued will likely incur high cancellation and/or reissue fees. These fees are typically set by the airline and are outside of our control.

Insurance - Adequate travel insurance that includes medical coverage for Covid-19 is required. Please contact your preferred travel insurance provider. The responsibility to obtain adequate travel insurance rests with the passenger. Proof of your travel insurance is required to be presented to us on or before the final payment date of the tour.

Passports - All travellers require a current passport with at least 6 months left on it at the end of the tour. Non-Australian passport holders require a re-entry visa for Australia. An Electronic Travel Authorisation (ETA) is required for Kenya. The cost is USD \$30 per person. For Tanzania, a visa can be obtained on arrival. The cost is USD \$50 per person. Please note these prices are subject to change.

Basic Tour Price and Taxes - Air taxes and fuel levies are included in the basic tour price if the tour is paid in full on or before the due date on the final invoice. Macleay Valley Travel reserves the right to charge for any increase in air taxes and fuel levies if the tour is not paid in full by the due date.

Not Included in the Cost - All items of a personal nature such as telephone calls, drinks, excess baggage, tips, meals, (except those specified in the itinerary), etc. Also travel insurance and departure taxes.
