## **Itinerary for European Waterways Cruise – Bucharest to Vienna**

Included meals are indicated as B = Breakfast, L = Lunch, D = Dinner

### **06.06.25 Australia – Doha, Qatar**

Depart Sydney at 8.45pm on QR 909, arriving in Doha at 4.55am the next morning.  
Depart Melbourne at 9.00pm on QR 905, arriving in Doha at 4.30am the next morning.  
Depart Brisbane at 10.15pm on QR 899, arriving in Doha at 6.00am the next morning.

### **07.06.25 Doha – Bucharest, Romania**

All passengers depart Doha at 9.10am on QR 221, arriving in Bucharest, Romania at 2.00pm.

Upon arrival we are transferred to the hotel for a two night stay.

### **08.06.25 Bucharest**

**(B)**

After breakfast we enjoy a full day city tour of Bucharest, viewing the main sites of the city including the Palace of the Parliament and the Old Town. Our tour includes an inside visit to Primaverii Palace, the former private residence of the late Dictator Nicolae Ceausescu, one of the most famous figures in Romania's history. He was the last dictator of communist Romania and the country's president between 1965 and 1989. We also visit a museum. At the conclusion of the tour we are returned to the hotel.

### **09.06.25 Bucharest – Oltenita**

**(B/D)**

This morning is at leisure. We check out of our hotel at the usual check-out time. After this our bags can be stored at the hotel while we have free time to further explore the city. Later this afternoon we depart the hotel for a 65km drive to the cruise port in Oltenita. Boarding commences at 6pm.

The Ms Vivaldi was built in 2009. The three deck vessel is 110 metres long and can carry 176 passengers. The ship has a refined and elegant atmosphere with facilities that include a dining room, lounge bar, dance floor, gift shop and large sundeck with WIFI onboard. The cabins are either twin bed or double bed configuration, and are equipped with satellite television, radio, hairdryer and safe.

This evening we will meet the crew and enjoy a welcome cocktail and dinner. Our ship will cruise through the night to Cernavoda.

### **10.06.25 Cernavoda – Danube-Black Sea Canal – Constanta**

**(B/L/D)**

Morning sailing on the Danube-Black Sea Canal. The completion of the canal was a huge undertaking for Romania and Eastern Europe. In the late morning we arrive in Constanta. Founded by the Greeks in the 7th century BC, it now has a population of over 560,000 inhabitants and is the second biggest port on the Black Sea after Istanbul. We will visit the Museum of History and Archaeology, which brings together items found during archaeological excavations. We also see a beautiful mosaic dating from the 3<sup>rd</sup> century. Then we discover an architectural melting pot including the Roman mosque (outside visit only) and the Orthodox Church (inside visit) as well as the

Genoese Lighthouse. Don't miss the beautiful view over Old Constanta from the pier. We'll walk along the waterfront all the way to the majestic Casino (outside visit only), built in the early 20th century in Austrian Art Nouveau style. It reminds us of Constanta in its heyday, when it used to be the favourite holiday destination of the idle rich. Moving on towards Murfatlar, which produces the best wines in Romania. This winery is over 4000 hectares and is one of the largest in Europe. There will be a wine tasting session in a cellar before returning to the ship.

Tonight we enjoy dinner onboard and an evening of traditional folklore.

**11.06.25 Constanta – Cernavoda - Oltenita**

**(B/L/D)**

We spend the day sailing through the Danube-Black Sea Canal. Construction began in the 1950s and the canal was inaugurated in 1984, making it the third longest in the world after the Suez and Panama canals. Take advantage of this day to relax on the sun deck and take part in the activities on board. Our ship will cruise through the night towards Oltenita

**12.06.25 Oltenita – Giurgiu – Excursion to Bucharest – Ruse, Bulgaria**

**(B/L/D)**

Today we enjoy a guided tour of Bucharest, which offers a striking combination of architectural styles including orthodox churches, Empire-style manor houses and Communist-inspired architecture. According to legend, the city was founded by a shepherd called Bucur, which means 'joy' in Romanian. Bucharest has suffered greatly from its communist past, but has somewhat modernised since the year 2000, due to significant economic growth.

We'll start our visit with a panoramic tour of the city giving an overview of the various monuments of the capital. We'll then head to a restaurant for a typical Romanian lunch with traditional music and folklore dancing to entertain us. After lunch, we'll visit Bucharest's Eco-museum, a genuine village in the city where we'll learn about the habitats of the different regions of Romania and their handicrafts. We'll conclude our visit with a photo stop at the Palace of Parliament, a gigantic neo-classical style marble construction designed by Ceausescu, before visiting the Orthodox Church.

Afterwards we return to our ship and cruise to Ruse, one of the biggest ports in Bulgaria. This evening enjoy traditional entertainment onboard the ship.

**13.06.25 Ruse**

**(B/L/D)**

This morning we depart the ship by coach to visit the rock monastery of St Dimitar Basarabovski. The monastery is the only functional men's rock monastery in Bulgaria, a site filled with history and still a place of worship. We then have a city tour of Ruse, with its impressive broad avenues, large squares and wonderful buildings which pay tribute to the architecture of the national Renaissance. Ruse was founded by the Romans under the orders of Emperor Augustus. We'll see the Dohodno Zdanie, the Roman Catholic St Paul of the Cross Cathedral and the Monument of Liberty. Following this we have some free time before returning to the ship by coach.

This afternoon we cruise through two countries, with Romania on the left bank and Bulgaria on the right bank. Our ship will continue to cruise through the night.

**14.06.25 The Iron Gates**  
**(B/L/D)** The day will be spent cruising on the Danube, sailing through Romania, Bulgaria and Serbia. Our ship will pass through the Iron Gates, the gorge on the Danube between the Carpathians and the Balkans. On the Serbian bank of the river, we'll catch a glimpse of the Tabula Traiana, a marble plaque honouring the Roman Road that once linked Rome to the province of Dacia.  
Accommodation: Onboard

**15.06.25 Belgrade – Novi Sad, Serbia**  
**(B/L/D)** This morning we arrive in Belgrade, and have a guided tour of the Serbian capital. Belgrade is one of the oldest cities in Europe, with a history stretching back some 7,000 years. The city is located at the confluence of the Sava and the Danube rivers, close to the Morava Corridor, which links the countries of the Danube to the Aegean Sea. We begin our visit with a panoramic city tour, during which we will have the opportunity to see Belgrade's National Theatre and National Museum, the Royal Palace, which currently houses the City Assembly of Belgrade, the Ancient Royal Palace and more. We'll stop to visit the Orthodox Temple of St Sava. The construction of this church began in 1939 and is still a work in progress following the Second World War and Tito's dictatorship. We have some free time in the city centre, before transferring to Kalemegdan Park, the largest and most beautiful park in the city. This afternoon we have an excursion to visit Krusedol Monastery, located in the mountainous region of Fruska Gora. Be delighted by the magnificent paintings from the 18<sup>th</sup> century that adorn this beautiful 16<sup>th</sup> century monastery. We then set off by coach to visit the town of Novi Sad, capital of the autonomous region of Vojvodina and the second largest town in Serbia. The town has a long and troubled history, being under the rule of the Celts, Romans, Franks, Barbarians and Turks until it became part of the Habsburg Empire. The history of the town was further troubled during the 20th century when after the First World War, the Balkan territories were in turn united and separated under different names, until in 2006 when the town finally became part of an independent Serbia. We'll visit the city centre on foot and the Austro-Hungarian old town, with its baroque buildings which were established around the ancient fortifications. We'll get the chance to visit the Episcopal Church as well as an orthodox church before we continue up the main street to Freedom Square where we'll find the town hall, dating from 1895. The coach will be waiting for us near Freedom Square to finish the visit with a panoramic tour up the main boulevards. Afterwards we return to our ship in Novi Sad and start cruising in the direction of the Mohacs.

**16.06.25 Mohacs – Kalocsa, Hungary**  
**(B/L/D)** Today we arrive in Mohacs. In the afternoon we have an included excursion to the Puszta, also known as the Great Plain of Hungary. We depart by coach in the company of our host in the direction of Kiskunsag Park, at the heart of the Puszta. The Puszta is a large, flat grassland that was regarded as the 'Wild West of Hungary' in the 19th century with cowboys watching over colossal cattle herds grazing on pasture. The Puszta has been listed as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO since 1999. Riding aboard a charabanc (traditional horse-drawn carriage with wooden benches) we'll be amazed by the wonderful landscapes and unusual fauna of the Puszta. In a small part of the Hungarian Steppe, we'll get a chance to observe Racka sheep with their spiral-shaped horns, Mangalica pigs with their curly coats and Hungarian Grey cattle with

their long, curved horns, as well as rare species of birds. In the course of our visit, we'll also get the chance to attend a traditional equestrian show while tasting "palinka" and some "pogacsa" (small savoury buns) as well as mineral water, sheltered from the sun under a thatched roof. The csikós, the mounted horse-herdsmen of Hungary dressed in traditional blue attire, will invite us to take part in their games of skill and ability. Afterwards we return by coach to our ship in Kalocsa and then cruise through the night to Budapest. This evening we enjoy a Hungarian feast onboard.

**17.06.25 Budapest, Hungary**

**(B/L/D)**

This morning we have an included panoramic tour of Budapest, the Pearl of the Danube. First we will head for the hills of Buda by crossing the Elizabeth Bridge and we will go up to the Castle Quarter, from where we'll enjoy a fantastic panoramic view of the city. We will walk round the Castle Quarter and on to the Fisherman's Bastion, built in neo-Roman style in 1902. Behind the Bastion, we will find Matthias Church, the oldest church in the city founded in 1015 by Saint Stephen, which notably was the venue for the coronation of Emperor Franz Joseph and his wife "Sissi". Our coach will take us down to the plains of Pest. There, we will visit Heroes' Square whose central monument depicting Prince Arpad and the chieftains of seven Magyar tribes was built for the millennium of Hungary. We will pass by the famous Szechenyi thermal baths, the zoo, Vajdahunyad Castle and more. We will walk through the famous Andrassy Avenue and pass by St. Stephen's Basilica whose construction began in 1851 and was not completed until 1905. We will walk along the river and see the famous Parliament building overlooking the Danube with its white silhouette in the Byzantine and neo-Gothic styles. Afterwards we return to the ship, with the remainder of the afternoon at leisure. Our ship sails to Bratislava, cruising through the night.

**18.06.25 Bratislava, Slovakia**

**(B/L/D)**

This morning we arrive in Bratislava, Slovakia. Before becoming the capital of independent Slovakia in 1993, Bratislava was the capital of Hungary from 1536 to 1784 under its former name Presburg. It then belonged to Czechoslovakia before becoming the capital of the Slovak Socialist Republic as part of Czechoslovakia between 1969 and 1992.

In the afternoon we will commence a panoramic tour of the city, which will take us to Bratislava Castle (outside visit), which dates from 1811, after the previous castle burned down. From here we will enjoy a breathtaking view over the Danube and the city below. The main historical monuments are located in the Old Town and the coach will drop us off at the entrance to the Old Town to continue our visit on foot. We will enter the city through Michael's Gate, which is the only gate still surviving from the Middle-Ages. Then we will head for the central square, surrounded by elegant buildings and dominated by the old Bratislava Town Hall. The tour continues with the Primate's Palace (outside visit) completed in 1781 for Archbishop Jozef Bathányi. As we stroll through the streets, we may come across some of the amusing statues that are dotted around the capital. After the tour there is some free time before returning to the ship on foot or by coach, depending on sailing times. Later we set sail for Vienna and enjoy a gala evening onboard.

Accommodation: Onboard

**19.06.25 Vienna, Austria****(B/L/D)**

In the morning we will commence our included tour of Vienna by taking the famous Ring to reach Schoenbrunn Palace. The "Ring" was one of the personal projects of Emperor Franz Joseph. In 1857, he decided to take down the ramparts that enclosed the city centre and had this boulevard built lined with fine buildings. Along the Ring we can admire this architectural showcase of the old Austro-Hungarian monarchy, including the State Opera, the Hofburg Palace, the Natural History Museum, the City Hall, the Burgtheater and more.

When we arrive at Schoenbrunn Palace, we will be guided through the numerous rooms of the Hapsburgs' summer residence, which bear witness to the splendour of the court at the time of Maria Theresa. We will also have some time to wander through the palace gardens.

Afterwards we are transferred to the city centre to enjoy some free time in the area around St Stephen's Cathedral. We will then return to the coach and transfer back to the ship via the Ring. This evening we have an included dinner onboard the ship reminisce about our time in Eastern Europe.

Accommodation: Onboard

**20.06.25 Vienna****(B)**

This morning we have breakfast onboard and then disembark the ship around 9am. We are transferred to our hotel for a two night stay. The remainder of the day is at leisure.

Accommodation: Acom-Hotel Vienna or similar

**21.06.25 Vienna****(B)**

Another day at leisure in Vienna to do as much or as little as you please.

Accommodation: Acom-Hotel Vienna or similar

**22.06.25 Vienna – Doha – Australia****(B)**

Early morning transfer from the hotel to the airport for our flights home.

Depart Vienna at 9.35am on QR 190, arriving in Doha at 3.55pm.

Sydney passengers depart Doha at 8.05pm on QR 908, arriving in Sydney at 5.10pm the next afternoon (23.06.25).

Melbourne passengers depart Doha at 8.15pm on QR 904, arriving in Melbourne at 4.45pm the next afternoon (23.06.25).

Brisbane passengers depart Doha at 8.25pm on QR 898, arriving in Brisbane at 5.30pm the next afternoon (23.06.25).

**23.06.25 Arrive Australia**

Flights arrive into Sydney, Melbourne and Brisbane late this afternoon.

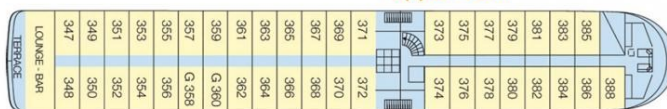

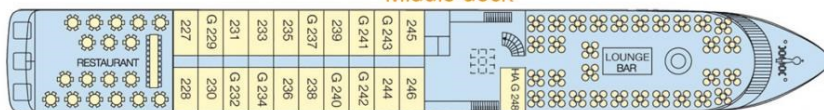
Sun deck



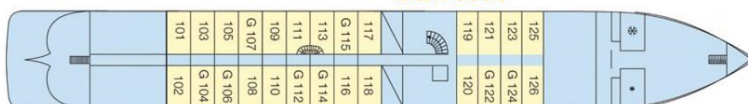
Upper deck

## **INFORMATION ABOUT THE CRUISE**

Breakfast is a self-serve buffet in the onboard restaurant, which may include pastries, coffee, tea, juice, breads, jams, a variety of sausages and cold cuts, eggs, fresh fruit and yoghurt.

Lunch and dinner will be 3 course sit down meals prepared by the onboard chefs and served at set times and in a single seating for all passengers. The meals often include local specialities, made from fresh ingredients. Both lunch and dinner meals are paired with excellent complimentary wines. Free beverages are provided with every meal, including mineral water, fruit juice, tea, coffee, house wine and beer. Champagne, premium wines and spirits are available at an additional charge.

The cabins on the cruise have individual controls for air conditioning and heat, so you can adjust your room to meet your needs. Each cabin is equipped with satellite television, a radio, hairdryer and safe. For your personal comfort all cabins are equipped with a shower, toilet and sink, and are provided with towels, but not washcloths. There are no laundry or ironing facilities onboard. Entertainment on board consists of various pre-dinner games, dinner-dances and other lively evenings in the lounge.

The primary language onboard the ship is French, however the majority of the staff and tour guides are fluent in English. Notices and announcements are in French and English.

The primary currency onboard is the Euro. Visa, MasterCard and American Express are also accepted. There are no currency exchange facilities onboard.

Electricity onboard is 220V. You will need to bring a standard two-pin 'European' adaptor for your electrical items.

The dress code is typically smart casual attire. Bring a variety of clothing for the environments expected on the cruise, including a rain coat and/or small umbrella.

Tipping – It is ship policy that any tips received will be shared equally among all crew members.

An acceptable tipping guideline is 5 – 10 Euros per person, per day, with the understanding that tipping is entirely at your discretion. To leave a tip, please use the envelope found in your cabin on your last evening onboard.

Free Wi-Fi internet is available in the lounge area of the ship. One Samsung Galaxy Tablet per ship is also available for guest use.

There is no doctor or nurse available on the ship.

Your accommodation on the ship is based on lower deck cabins. If you wish you can upgrade to a middle deck cabin for an extra charge of \$370 per person twin share, or an upper deck cabin for an extra charge of \$440 per person twin share. All cabins are similar size on each deck, but the middle and upper deck cabins have larger windows, which can also be opened.

## Conditions for Macleay Valley Travel's European Waterways Tour

**Deposits and Payments** - A non-refundable deposit of \$800 per person is payable within 7 days of booking. This deposit is not refundable should you later cancel. The balance is payable in full 14 weeks prior to departure. Macleay Valley Travel has to adhere to strict payment deadlines and your booking on the tour may be cancelled if final payment is not received by the due date, with no refund applicable.

**Refunds and Cancellations** - Cancellations after final payment will result in a refund limited to whatever we can recoup from the airline. Any refund for a cancelled booking will not be paid until the airline(s) have provided said refund.

**Airline Tickets** - With this tour, airline tickets will be issued very soon after booking. Please note that any changes made to airline tickets once they have been issued will likely incur high cancellation and/or reissue fees. These fees are typically set by the airline and are outside of our control.

**Insurance** - Adequate travel insurance that includes medical coverage for Covid-19 is required. Please contact your preferred travel insurance provider. The responsibility to obtain adequate travel insurance rests with the passenger. Proof of your travel insurance is required to be presented to us on or before the final payment date of the tour.

**Passports** - All travellers require a current passport with at least 6 months left on it at the end of the tour. Non-Australian passport holders require a re-entry visa for Australia. From early 2025, Australian citizens travelling to the EU will require an ETIAS (European Travel Information and Authorisation System) for stays of up to 90 days. This is otherwise known as a European visa waiver. The expected cost for this is 7 Euros per person. No other visas are required if travelling on an Australian passport.

**Basic Tour Price and Taxes** - Air taxes and fuel levies are included in the basic tour price if the tour is paid in full on or before the due date on the final invoice. Macleay Valley Travel reserves the right to charge for any increase in air taxes and fuel levies if the tour is not paid in full by the due date.

**Not Included in the Cost** - All items of a personal nature such as telephone calls, drinks, excess baggage, tips, meals, (except those specified in the itinerary), etc. Also travel insurance and departure taxes. Similarly, credit card payments (Visa/MasterCard) can only be accepted if 1.2% is added to the price to help defray the heavy merchant fees charged to us by the credit card companies.
