## **Itinerary for Strasbourg to Budapest River Cruise**

Included meals are indicated as B = Breakfast, L = Lunch, D = Dinner

### **08.09.25 Australia – Dubai**

Depart Brisbane at 9.00pm on Emirates flight EK 435, arriving in Dubai at 5.10am the next morning.

Depart Sydney at 9.10pm on Emirates flight EK 413, arriving in Dubai at 5.40am the next morning.

Depart Melbourne at 9.15pm on Emirates flight EK 407, arriving in Dubai at 5.15am the next morning.

### **09.09.25 Dubai – Paris, France**

All passengers depart Dubai at 8.20am on flight EK 73, arriving in Paris at 1.30pm.

On arrival in Paris we will be met and transferred to our hotel for a three night stay.

### **10.09.25 Paris – Palace of Versailles – Paris**

**(B)** Today we will have a half day excursion with visits to Versailles Palace and Gardens with a guide. The Palace of Versailles is a former French royal residence that was primarily a hunting lodge and private retreat for Louis XIII who reigned from 1610-1643. The building is now a national landmark and museum with beautiful adjoining gardens located just outside of Paris. Afterwards we return to the hotel and have the remainder of the day at leisure.

### **11.09.25 Paris**

**(B)** Today is at leisure in Paris. Our hotel is conveniently located close to the Metro station for us to explore the sights of this wonderful city, or check out the nearby shops and restaurants in the vicinity.

### **12.09.25 Paris – Strasbourg – Mainz, Germany**

**(B/D)** This morning we are collected from our hotel by a local guide for a visit to the Eiffel Tower, one of the most famous landmarks in the world. The Eiffel Tower was built by Gustav Eiffel from 1887 to 1889, to celebrate the 100 year anniversary of the French Revolution. At 324 metres tall, the tower is the tallest structure in Paris. During its construction, the Eiffel Tower surpassed the Washington Monument to become the tallest man-made structure in the world. A title which it held for 41 years. Our visit will take us to the second level of the tower, which is 115 metres high and offers incredible views of the city. Our visit to the tower will be to the second level viewing platform. Please note that this visit is subject to availability as tickets usually sell out very soon after they are released.

Following this, we enjoy a one hour cruise on the River Seine. The cruise commences at the Eiffel Tower and goes upriver, around Notre Dame. We pass the Musee d'Orsay, Louvre and the replica of the Statue of Liberty.

Later this afternoon we transfer to Paris train station for our high speed train trip to Strasbourg (second class). Upon arrival at Strasbourg train station we are transferred

to the cruise terminal to board our ship, the MS Modigliani. Boarding commences at 6pm.

Named in honour of the famous Italian painter, the MS Modigliani was built in 2001 and completely renovated in 2011. This ship is 110 metres long and can accommodate 159 passengers, spread over two decks. It is a friendly and comfortable ship with facilities that include a restaurant, lounge bar with dance floor, small library and large sundeck. All cabins are located above water level and offer panoramic views. The cabins are either twin bed or double bed configuration, and are equipped with independently controlled air conditioning, Wi-Fi, television, hairdryer, bathroom and safe.

This evening we will meet the crew and enjoy a welcome cocktail and dinner while we cruise to Mainz.

### **13.09.25 Mainz – Frankfurt - Miltenberg**

**(B/L/D)**

This morning we arrive in Mainz which is situated on the west bank of the Rhine River. In the past the city was the residence of bishops who had a major role in the history of the Saint-Empire. We discover the city with a walking tour guided by the ship's hostess and then cruise to Frankfurt, which is a major business hub and has Germany's most imposing skyline. The city has an unrivalled museum scene featuring masterpieces spanning nine centuries of European art. Our excursion of Frankfurt will begin with a panoramic tour of the city by coach. Then we'll leave the coach behind to visit the city on foot. After passing in front of the dominant Frankfurt Cathedral, we'll discover the old city and the Romerberg, the seat of the city's government since the 15<sup>th</sup> century. Here we'll also find a plaque commemorating the book burning by the National Socialists in 1933. After the tour we have some free time before returning to the ship on foot. Later we cruise to Miltenberg.

### **14.09.25 Miltenberg - Wertheim**

**(B/L/D)**

Early in the morning we arrive in Miltenberg. We discover this peaceful town with a walking tour. Miltenberg is a beautiful city that has streets with half timbered houses which are still protected by ramparts and medieval doors. Next we cruise to Wertheim which is situated in the confluence of the Tauber and the Main Rivers. Upon arrival in Wertheim we have some time at leisure to explore the town.

### **15.09.25 Wertheim – Würzburg - Kitzingen**

**(B/L/D)**

Today we cruise toward Karlstad and depart by coach for a visit to Würzburg, situated on the right bank of the Main River in the Northern Bavaria region of Germany. Our tour will start with a visit to the Würzburg Residence, former palace of the Prince-Bishops of Würzburg. Construction was commissioned by Prince-Bishop Friedrich Carl von Schönborn as a replacement for the old Marienberg Fortress and lasted between 1720 and 1780. We'll discover 40 rooms richly decorated with furniture, paintings and tapestries by 18<sup>th</sup> century master artists and climb up the monumental Main Staircase designed by Balthasar Neumann. Among others, we will visit the Baroque Imperial Hall whose frescoes were the works of Italian painter Giovanni Battista Tiepolo, and the Imperial Apartments richly decorated in Rococo style. Our tour will continue downtown where we will have

some free time before returning on board by coach.

Later we cruise to the town of Kitzingen. This evening relax and enjoy some entertainment onboard the ship.

**16.09.25 Kitzingen – Rothenburg - Bamberg**

**(B/L/D)**

We cruise to Schweinfurt to depart the ship for our guided tour to Rothenburg, a magnificent walled town set up high on the hills over the river. Accompanied by a local guide, we will discover the 15<sup>th</sup> century ramparts, the Spital Bastion, the Market Square with the Town Hall and the famous St James's Church (exterior). After the guided walking tour, we have some free time to stroll through the romantic streets, visit some of the museums such as the Criminal Museum exhibiting instruments of torture, the Christmas Museum or the Doll and Toy Museum, or have a taste of some of the local specialties. We return to the ship by coach and then cruise to Bamberg.

**17.09.25 Bamberg – Nuremberg - Muhlhausen**

**(B/L/D)**

Sail on the Rhine-Main-Danube Canal, which was opened on the 25<sup>th</sup> September 1992. It took 70 years to build this 171km long canal. We have lunch onboard before arriving in Nuremberg and have a guided tour of Nuremberg by coach. Enjoy a panoramic visit of the monuments found outside of the city's medieval walls, including the Nuremberg Palace of Justice, the Nazi Documentation Centre and Party Rally Grounds, the castle area, etc. You'll discover the charming side streets and beautiful half-timbered houses before arriving in the Marktplatz. On foot, see the gorgeous Schöner Brunnen (beautiful fountain) and the Frauenkirche. During our tour, we'll stop and taste one of the local specialties, Lebkuchen, the city's famous gingerbread.

Afterwards we reboard the ship and cruise to Muhlhausen, arriving in the evening. Tonight we enjoy entertainment provided by our crew.

**18.09.25 Muhlhausen - Regensburg**

**(B/L/D)**

This morning we cruise to Kelheim. In the afternoon we enjoy an included excursion to Regensburg. Regensburg has a decisive importance in the fields of culture and medieval art. We visit the Walhalla, a huge Greek style marble temple which overhangs the Danube. In the company of our guide, we'll set off on a visit of Regensburg by foot and discover the imposing stone-built 'Porta Praetoria' - the northern gate to the Roman fortress - the Old Town Hall containing the rooms occupied by the Imperial diet from 1663 to 1806, the Gothic Cathedral and the Italian influenced homes of wealthy merchants from the Middle-Ages.

Afterwards we return to our ship which will be waiting for us at Regensburg.

**19.09.25 Regensburg - Passau**

**(B/L/D)**

This morning cruise to Passau, a German city situated on the Austrian border. The city is overlooked by Veste Oberhaus, a 13<sup>th</sup> century hilltop fortress housing a city museum and observation tower. The old town below is known for its narrow romantic streets and baroque buildings, including St Stephen's cathedral, featuring

distinctive onion-domed towers and an organ with 17,974 pipes. There is an opportunity for you to discover the town on your own. Return to the ship and cruise through the attractive Austrian region of Engelhartzell.

Accommodation: Onboard

**20.09.25 Passau – Melk – Durnstein - Vienna, Austria**

**(B/L/D)**

Early morning cruising to Melk. We enjoy an excursion to the Benedictine Abbey of Melk, which towers over the Danube and is the symbol of baroque art in Austria. Among other things, we will visit the marble hall, the world famous library and the bedchambers where a number of illustrious visitors have slept. Next we sail to Durnstein and have some free time in this picturesque village. Close to the Danube River, Durnstein is a lovely medieval town.

Later in the afternoon we return onboard and cruise to Vienna, which is the capital city of Austria and known for its art, history and music.

This evening we enjoy a tour of the illuminated sights of Vienna by night.

This 2,000 year old city is a true open-air museum. Vienna embodies Romanticism through its powerful architecture and numerous monuments. We'll take the famous Ring which encircles historic Vienna, on the right bank of the Danube. Our coach will go past a multitude of buildings that were erected under the old Austro-Hungarian monarchy, being the Opera, the City Hall, the Hofburg and many official buildings. We will stop at Schwarzenbergplatz with a monument in honour of Johann Strauss. Then, a walk around Albertina quarter to admire Hofburg Palace, the winter residence of the Habsburgs which today houses the Sisi Museum, as well as the Augustinian Church where Franz Joseph and Sisi's wedding was conducted.

We return to our ship by coach and overnight onboard the ship in Vienna.

**21.09.25 Vienna – Esztergom, Hungary**

**(B/L/D)**

This morning we immerse ourselves in Austrian history with a tour of Schonbrunn Palace. On the tour we will be taken through numerous rooms of the Hapsburg's summer residence, which bear witness to the splendour of the Court at the time of Maria Theresa. We will also have some time to wander through the palace gardens. We will then be taken to the city centre to enjoy some free time near St Stephens Cathedral. Following this we return to the ship by coach. Later we sail to Esztergom, passing through Bratislava, Slovakia.

This evening we have a Gala dinner and dancing onboard.

Accommodation: Onboard

**22.09.25 Esztergom - Budapest**

**(B/L/D)**

At leisure in Esztergom, which is a city located on the border of Hungary and Slovakia. The city was the capital of Hungary from the 10<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup> century, before it was moved to Budapest. The town is full of treasures with its neo-classic basilica and former Royal Palace. We set sail for Budapest around noon and enjoy lunch onboard. We arrive in Budapest in the mid afternoon and have some free time to explore the city before returning to the ship for dinner.

This evening we have a Budapest by night tour from the comfort of our coach.

Our guide will show us the charms of this capital city with its turbulent but incredibly rich past. Despite the vicissitudes of history, Budapest has managed to preserve and bear witness to a succession of dynasties and civilisations. We'll start off towards the citadel for an impressive view over the city and on Pest. We'll then

walk up to the citadel and the Liberty Statue from where we'll get to marvel at the most beautiful view of Budapest and the Danube, as well as catch a glimpse of the Parliament building and the famous Chain Bridge. We'll continue by coach towards the Castle Quarter from where you'll get to admire the Royal Palace, the former residence of the Hungarian kings. As we drive alongside the banks of Buda, we'll stop off before the Parliament building to admire and take pictures of the largest building in the country. We'll continue across Margaret Bridge and enjoy a beautiful view of downtown Budapest. Before returning, our coach will drive along the Danube so we can enjoy once again the wonderful view over Buda, the Castle Quarter and the Fishermen's Bastion.

Accommodation: Onboard

**23.09.25 Budapest**

**(B/L/D)**

This morning we have a sightseeing tour of Budapest, the 'Pearl of the Danube'. First we head to the hills of Buda, crossing the Elizabeth Bridge and go up to the Castle quarter, where we will have an amazing view of the city. We walk around the Castle quarter and onto the Fisherman's Bastion, where we will find the Matthias Church, the oldest in the city, founded in 1015 by Saint Stephen. This was the venue for the coronation of Emperor Franz Joseph and his wife 'Sissi'. We then return to the coach and descend to the plains of Pest. We visit Hero's Square, whose central monument depicts Prince Arpad and his chieftains. We will pass the famous Szechenyi thermal baths, the zoo and Vajdahunyad Castle. We travel along Andrassy Avenue and pass in front of St Stephens Basilica which was constructed from 1851 to 1905. We will travel along the river and see the famous Parliament building overlooking the Danube, with its white silhouette in the Byzantine and neo-Gothic styles. Afterwards we return to the ship for some free time.

This evening we travel to a downtown theatre for a traditional Hungarian show. The 90 minute show will take us across all the regions of Hungary through its folklore and Gypsy dance and music. A fitting way to farewell your European river cruise.

**24.09.25 Budapest – Dubai**

**(B)**

This morning we disembark the cruise ship and are transferred to the airport for our flights home.

Depart Budapest at 4.00pm on EK 112, arriving in Dubai at 11.20pm.

**25.09.25 Dubai - Australia**

Sydney passengers depart Dubai at 02.15am on EK 414, arriving in Sydney at 10.05pm.

Brisbane passengers depart Dubai at 02.30am on EK 430, arriving in Brisbane at 10.20pm.

Melbourne passengers depart Dubai at 02.40am on EK 408, arriving in Melbourne at 9.50pm.

### Tour Difficulty Level 3

This tour rating typically involves a good level of physical activity, such as ascending stairs, getting into a bathtub shower, being responsible for your own luggage at airports and hotels, boarding trains quickly with your luggage, walking distances of up to 500 metres at a time over possible uneven ground and/or cobblestone streets. Walking tours of considerable distances should be expected on tours with this rating as well as some early departures.

## **INFORMATION ABOUT THE CRUISE**

Breakfast is a self-serve buffet in the onboard restaurant, which may include pastries, coffee, tea, juice, breads, jams, a variety of sausages and cold cuts, eggs, fresh fruit and yoghurt.

Lunch and dinner will be 3 course sit down meals prepared by the onboard chefs and served at set times and in a single seating for all passengers. The meals often include local specialities, made from fresh ingredients. Both lunch and dinner meals are paired with excellent complimentary wines. Free beverages are provided with every meal, including mineral water, fruit juice, tea, coffee, house wine and beer. Champagne, premium wines and spirits are available at an additional charge.

The cabins on the cruise have individual controls for air conditioning and heating, so you can adjust your room to meet your needs. Each cabin is equipped with satellite television, a radio, hairdryer and safe. For your personal comfort all cabins are equipped with a shower, toilet and sink, and are provided with towels, but not washcloths. There are no laundry or ironing facilities onboard. Entertainment on board consists of various pre-dinner games, dinner-dances and other lively evenings in the lounge.

The primary language onboard the ship is French, however the majority of the staff and tour guides are fluent in English. Notices and announcements are in French and English.

The primary currency onboard is the Euro. Visa, MasterCard and American Express are also accepted. There are no currency exchange facilities onboard.

Electricity onboard is 220V. You will need to bring a standard two-pin 'European' adaptor for your electrical items.

The dress code is typically smart casual attire. Bring a variety of clothing for the environments expected on the cruise, including a rain coat and/or small umbrella.

Tipping – It is ship policy that any tips received will be shared equally among all crew members. An acceptable tipping guideline is 5 – 10 Euros per person, per day, with the understanding that tipping is entirely at your discretion. To leave a tip, please use the envelope found in your cabin on your last evening onboard.

Free Wi-Fi internet is available in the lounge area of the ship. One Samsung Galaxy Tablet per ship is also available for guest use.

There is no doctor or nurse available on the ship.

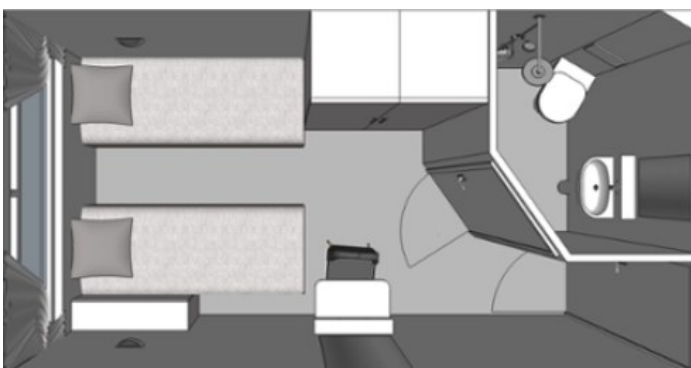
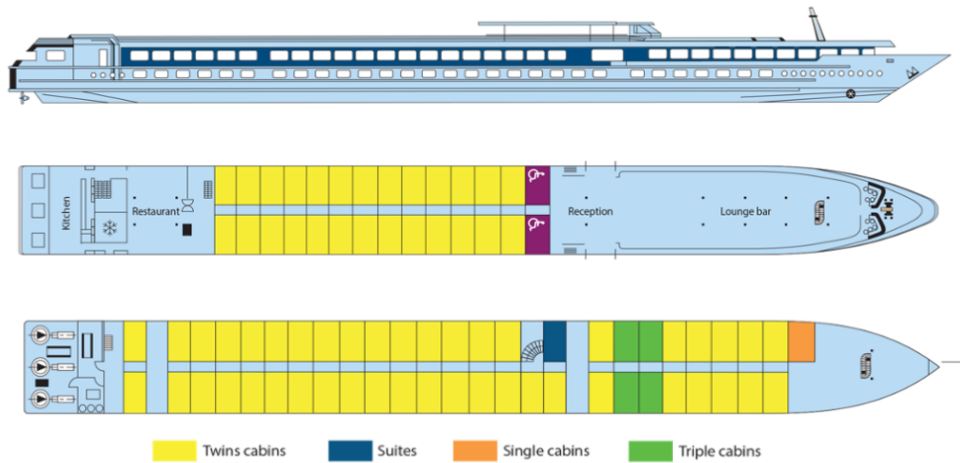


Your accommodation on the ship is based on lower deck cabins. If you wish you can upgrade to an upper deck cabin for an extra charge of \$399 per person twin share. All cabins are similar size on each deck, but the upper deck cabins have larger windows. The main deck cabin windows cannot be opened. The upper deck cabin windows have a small section at the top that can be opened.

## Conditions for Macleay Valley Travel's European Waterways Tour

**Deposits and Payments** - A non-refundable deposit of \$600 per person is payable within 7 days of booking. This deposit is not refundable should you later cancel. The balance is payable in full 14 weeks prior to departure. Macleay Valley Travel has to adhere to strict payment deadlines and your booking on the tour may be cancelled if final payment is not received by the due date, with no refund applicable.

**Refunds and Cancellations** - Cancellations after final payment will result in a refund limited to whatever we can recoup from the airline. Any refund for a cancelled booking will not be paid until the airline(s) have provided said refund.

**Airline Tickets** - Please note that any changes made to airline tickets once they have been issued will likely incur high cancellation and/or reissue fees. These fees are typically set by the airline and are outside of our control.

**Insurance** - Adequate travel insurance that includes medical coverage for Covid-19 is required. Please contact your preferred travel insurance provider. The responsibility to obtain adequate travel insurance rests with the passenger. Proof of your travel insurance is required to be presented to us on or before the final payment date of the tour.

**Passports** - All travellers require a current passport with at least 6 months left on it at the end of the tour. Non-Australian passport holders require a re-entry visa for Australia. From early 2025, Australian citizens travelling to the EU will require an ETIAS (European Travel Information and Authorisation System) for stays of up to 90 days. This is otherwise known as a European visa waiver. The expected cost for this is 7 Euros per person. No other visas are required if travelling on an Australian passport.

**Basic Tour Price and Taxes** - Air taxes and fuel levies are included in the basic tour price if the tour is paid in full on or before the due date on the final invoice. Macleay Valley Travel reserves the right to charge for any increase in air taxes and fuel levies if the tour is not paid in full by the due date.
