15.04.27 Australia - Singapore

Depart Brisbane at 6.10pm on SQ 266, arriving in Singapore at 00.10am.
Depart Melbourne at 6.25pm on SQ 208, arriving in Singapore at 00.15am.
Depart Sydney at 6.00pm on SQ 242, arriving in Singapore at 00.15am.

16.04.27 Singapore - Istanbul, Turkey

Transfer to your next flight.

All passengers depart Singapore at 02.15am on SQ 392, arriving in Istanbul at 8.30am. We are met at the airport and taken on a city tour of Istanbul.

We explore the old city of Istanbul and visit Topkapi Palace. It was first built by Mehmet the Conqueror in 1453 and was the home of the Sultan until the 19th century.

Later we are transferred to the hotel for a three night stay.

Accommodation: Holiday Inn Istanbul City or similar

17.04.27 Istanbul

(B) Today we visit the Hippodrome of Constantinople, which was the sporting and social centre of the city. We visit the Blue Mosque, which was commissioned by Sultan Ahmet in 1603 and was constructed with the deliberate intention of rivalling the St. Sophia. Following this we visit St. Sophia, which was built by the Roman Emperor Justinian and was completed in 537 A.D. For more than 1,000 years it was the largest Christian church in the world.

Later we will visit the Grand Bazaar in the old city.

Accommodation: Holiday Inn Istanbul City or similar

18.04.27 Istanbul

(B) In the morning we visit the Rustem Pasha Mosque with its exceptional tiles and the spice market. We then take a Bosphorus cruise on a private boat to see the spectacular historical palaces, houses and fortresses. In the afternoon we visit the Mosque of Suleyman the Magnificent.

Accommodation: Holiday Inn Istanbul City or similar

19.04.27 Istanbul – Gallipoli – Dardanelles – Canakkale

(B/D) This morning we leave Istanbul for Canakkale. On the way, we will visit Gallipoli to see the World War I memorial and battlefields such as ANZAC Cove, Chunuk Bair and Lone Pine Cemetery. Afterwards, we will take a ferry to Canakkale, a small city on the Dardanelles across from Gallipoli. Dinner this evening is included.

Accommodation: Iris Hotel or similar

20.04.27 Canakkale – Troy – Pergamon - Kusadasi

(B/D) This morning we will visit the legendary city of Troy and have the opportunity to see a replica of the Trojan horse. We will see nine different city settlements of ancient Troy in the same location, each one built on top of the other. Afterwards, we will

drive to Pergamon to see the Asklepion, which was perhaps the world's most famous ancient medical centre. We will drive to Kusadasi and check into our hotel for a two night stay. Dinner this evening is included.
Accommodation: Ramada Hotel & Suites or similar

21.04.27 Kusadasi – Ephesus - Kusadasi

(B/D)

Today we will drive to the incredible city of Ephesus and see its colossal Greek Theatre, which is still used for performances today. Among the many things we will be seeing are the Marble Road, the Celsus Library and the Temple of Diana. We will also visit the house where Virgin Mary lived her final days and the Ephesus Museum in Selcuk. Following this we return to our hotel in Kusadasi. Dinner this evening is included.

Accommodation: Ramada Hotel & Suites or similar

22.04.27 Kusadasi – Aphrodisias – Laodicea - Pamukkale

(B/D)

Today we will drive to Aphrodisias, the city of art and beauty, dedicated to the Goddess Aphrodite. We will see the ancient temple, the marble theatre and the immense stadium, which is the largest and best preserved in the world and seats over 35,000. We will also visit the spectacular museum of Aphrodisias. Afterwards, we will continue to Pamukkale. On the way we will visit Laodicea, which is one of the Seven Churches of Revelation, referred to in the bible. The site exhibits a spectacular ancient Roman temple, agora and ancient theatre.

We continue to Pamukkale, staying in a spa hotel, where we can swim in the heated pools of enriched mineral water. Dinner this evening is included.

Accommodation: Pam Thermal Hotel or similar

23.04.27 Pamukkale - Hierapolis - Antalya

(B/D)

This morning we visit the incredible ancient city of Hierapolis, which is world famous for its white calcium travertines. The Hierapolis has an incredible ancient necropolis (city of the dead), a spectacular Roman city gate, ancient agora and Roman baths. Afterwards we drive to Antalya. On the way we see the beautiful Salda Lake. This crater lake has a peaceful atmosphere with amazing views and colours. We arrive in Antalya in the late afternoon for a two night stay. Dinner this evening is included.

Accommodation: Adonis Hotel or similar

24.04.27 Antalya

(B/D)

Today we will tour the city, as well as visit the ancient ruins of Aspendos and Perge. Aspendos dates back to the time of the Hittites, yet the only visible remains are from the Roman period. The restored theatre is the best in all of Turkey. Perge reached its height under the Romans and Alexander the Great. Today, what remains are the ruins of a great theatre, a stadium and the colonnaded main street. In the afternoon we visit the excellent Antalya Archaeology Museum and the old city in the harbour. Dinner this evening is included.

Accommodation: Adonis Hotel or similar

25.04.27 Antalya – Konya

(B/D)

This morning we will drive to Konya to visit the Whirling Dervish Museum, a very holy place for Turkish Muslims. There are exhibits of Dervish costumes,

instruments, illuminated manuscripts and various ethnographic artefacts. We will also visit the Karatay Madrasa, a 13th century school, now a museum displaying historic ceramics and archaeological relics. We have an overnight stay in Konya. Dinner this evening is included.

Accommodation: Bayir Diamond Hotel or similar

26.04.27 Konya – Catalhoyuk - Cappadocia

(B/D)

Today we will visit Catalhoyuk, which is the best preserved and largest Neolithic site and is considered by archaeologists to be the oldest communal living city in the world. Two hills form the 37 hectare site on the Southern Anatolian Plateau. The taller Easter Mound contains eighteen levels of Neolithic occupation between 7,400 and 6,200 B.C. Layer by layer, archaeologists have excavated this tumulus/mound and put a cover over their excavations.

We then continue to Cappadocia. On the way we will visit the Sultan Han Caravanserai, which is a 13th century Seljuk Turkish monument on the ancient Silk Road. We will have a two night stay in Cappadocia. Dinner this evening is included. During our stay in Cappadocia, there should be an optional hot air balloon ride over Cappadocia for those who wish. This is a spectacular experience and suitable for people of all ages. The optional tour is booked locally through our tour guide. The estimated cost is 300 Euros per person, payable directly to the balloon company when in Turkey. The price is subject to change. Please note that the optional hot air balloon ride is subject to weather and operational conditions. In the event the balloon ride is cancelled, the balloon company will refund customers directly.

27.04.27 Cappadocia

(B/D)

In Cappadocia we will enjoy the unique landscape of volcanic rock formations, eroded by the wind and rain. We will tour the amazing underground churches and cities carved into the rocks by early Christians. Going off the tourist track, we will have wonderful strolls where we visit small villages and discover the unknown parts of Cappadocia. Today we will visit Magic Valley to see incredible red coloured rock formations, followed by Zelve Open Air Museum, which was once an amazing cave town. We will also visit the Pasabag Valley with unique conical rock formations and the White Valley, also known as Akvadi, to see how the rock formations geologically formed in Cappadocia. Dinner this evening is included.

Accommodation: Dinler Hotel or similar

28.04.27 Cappadocia - Ankara

(B/D)

Today we visit the Goreme Open Air Museum to see the best preserved ancient Christian frescoes in rock churches and monasteries. We will visit an underground city where early Christians took refuge and produced wine. We also see Uchisar rock fortress. In the afternoon we will visit some local handcraft manufacturing workshops to see carpet and ceramic production.

Later we drive to Ankara for an overnight stay. Dinner this evening is included.

Accommodation: Downtown Ankara Hotel or similar

29.04.27 Ankara – Istanbul

(B)

In the morning we visit the Mausoleum of Mustafa Kemal Ataturk, the founding father of modern Turkey. Following this we explore the spectacular Museum of

Anatolian Civilizations. In the afternoon we drive to Istanbul for an overnight stay.
Accommodation: Holiday Inn Istanbul City or similar

30.04.27 Istanbul – Singapore

(B) After breakfast this morning we transfer to the airport for our flights home.
All passengers depart Istanbul at 1.10pm on SQ 391, arriving in Singapore at 4.55am the next morning.

01.05.27 Singapore – Australia

Brisbane passengers depart Singapore at 7.20am on SQ 265, arriving in Brisbane at 4.55pm.

Sydney passengers depart Singapore at 7.15am on SQ 241, arriving in Sydney at 4.45pm.

Tour Difficulty Level 4

This tour rating typically involves an above average level of physical activity, such as ascending stairs, getting into a bathtub shower, being responsible for your own luggage at airports and hotels, walking distances of up to 2 kilometres at a time over possible uneven ground and/or cobblestone streets. Walking tours of considerable distances should be expected on tours with this rating as well as early departures. Unfortunately this tour rating is not recommended for individuals who cannot walk unaided.

Deposits and Payments - A non-refundable deposit of \$400 per person is payable within 7 days of booking. This deposit is not refundable should you later cancel. The balance is payable in full 10 weeks prior to departure.
